
First choose a position and orientation of your roof top tent on to your Gobi rack. Most common placement is the rear section deployed over the passenger side. Similar to the position of the cross bars shown below.




Orient the roof top tent upside down and install the Gobi cross bars onto the tent rails as shown below. Position the rails equally to both sides and snug down only at this time. Make sure to place a piece of rubber or the like between the Gobi cross bars, tent rails and clamp as shown on the next page






Place a piece of rubber or the like between the Gobi cross bar, tent clamp and rail as shown above. Orient the cross bar so that the longer clamp (A) is facing the tent base and the shorter clamp (B) is facing the vehicle as shown above





Premeasure the distance center to center between the Gobi rack's passenger and driver side roof rack rails where the tent will rest. Set the center curve (R) of clamp (A) both ends of the cross bar to the exact measurement of the roof rack rails, shown below. Orient the smaller lower clamp (B) sideways as shown and tighten down the clamps so they will not move during installation.
















ROOF TOP TENT INSTALLATION ONTO A GOBI RACK USING GOBI CROSS BARS COMPLETED
